Year 6 students who are attending Mirani State High school are required to attend orientation day on Thursday 4th December. More information regarding this will be sent home over the next few days.

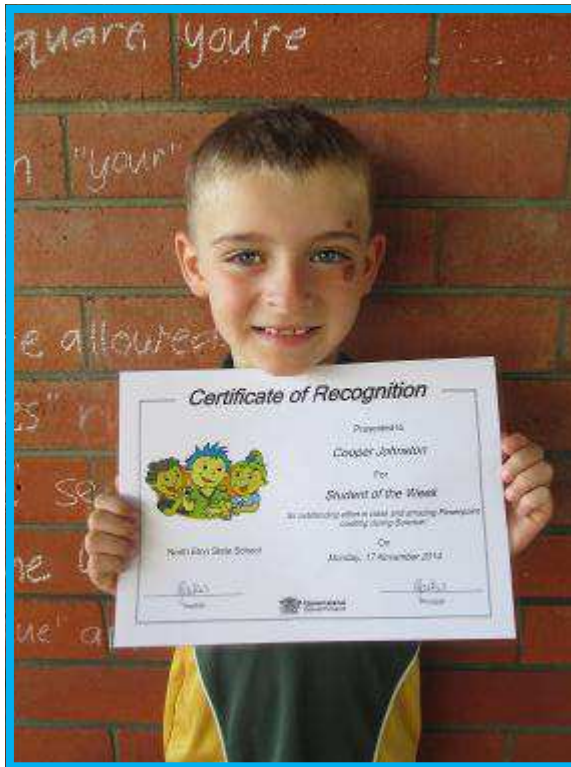
DONATION TO CHARITY
