- Further implement the use of Information, Communication and Technology (ICT) to transform the way that students think, learn, communicate and represent knowledge.

Our initiatives include:


- Continuing to implement Words Their Way and a daily writing program to lift and improve whole school writing fluency, ability and engagement.
- Improving capability, competence and consistency in teaching writing through focussed coaching, supervision and professional development.
- Introducing Visible Learning (Hattie) to improve student achievement in the classroom.

Purchasing Teacher Aide time to support Writing and Spelling Intervention Programs.	\$ 1,879
Releasing teachers for targeted professional development – collaborative planning, data conversations and moderation sessions (1 day per term).	\$ 2,000
Purchasing ICT hardware (Apple ipads).	\$ 930
Purchasing Visible Learning text books for all staff (x4).	\$ 553
