## **This funding will be used to**

- Ensure 100% of students in all year levels achieve a C or higher in all English tasks.
- Ensure 100% of students in Year 3 and 5 achieve National Minimum Standard (NMS) in reading (NAPLAN).
- Ensure 100% of students in all year levels are improving in relative gain.
- Ensure 100% of students are improving in reading diagnostic results semesterly.

## **Our initiatives include**

- Continue to implement a daily reading program to lift and improve whole school reading fluency, ability and engagement.
- Review and revise the current school reading program to ensure high impact strategies are being taught and assessed.
- Visit schools within the region to see Reading Programs in action (both Teachers and Teacher Aides)
- Improve capability, competence and consistency in teaching reading through focussed coaching, supervision and professional development.
- Continue to implement Heggarty's Phonemic Awareness for our P-2 cohort and as an intervention for our Year 3-6 cohort.

## **Our school will improve student outcomes by**

- Purchasing Teacher Aide time to support literacy intervention programs with a specific focus on reading - **\$5500**
- Purchase ipad apps to support the teaching and learning of reading - **\$419**
